John Kuntze our Drainage Engineer will be on site Aug 22 and 23 to discuss the Campbell and Rempel Drain reports. A thank you was received from Thunder Bay Regional Health Sciences Foundation for a \$100.00 donation to Tamarack House in memory of Mayor Armstrong.
