- E-BOOKS #15-81 JODOIN & LANGNER & CARRIED that the Council of the Township of Dawson support the resolution requesting the Minister of Tourism, Culture and Sport work with the Federal and the other provincial and territorial governments to find a solution that will allow public libraries to purchase e-books from publishers at a fair and reasonable price.
